

Tucker Tooley

Chief Executive Officer

An accomplished creative executive with studio management and extensive theatrical producing experience, Tucker Tooley is CEO of Tucker Tooley Entertainment, a feature film and television finance and production company established by Tooley and Greg Renker. Tooley's films have earned more than \$2.5 billion at the worldwide box office.

The company is set to release four feature films in 2024 including Arthur The King with Lionsgate, starring Mark Wahlberg and Simu Liu, which premieres domestically in theatres on March 22; The Deliverance with Netflix, director Lee Daniels' elevated horror film starring Andra Day, Glenn Close, Aunianue Ellis, Caleb McLaughlin, Mo'Nique, Demi Singleton and Omar Epps; Den of Thieves 2: Pantera (post-production), which the company co-financed with eOne, starring Gerard Butler and O'Shea Jackson, Jr. with director Christian Gudegast returning for the sequel to the successful heist thriller; and Finding Satoshi, a premium documentary that explores the mysterious founder of Bitcoin and the larger state of cryptocurrency with the help of best-selling author and financial journalist William D. Cohan.

Previous Tooley Entertainment films include Netflix's **Concrete Cowboy** starring Idris Elba, which opened number one in the U.S. and has been seen by more than 20 million people worldwide; Hulu's **The United States vs. Billie Holiday** directed by Academy Award nominee Lee Daniels and starring Andra Day, for which she earned a Best Actress Oscar® nomination and a Golden Globe win; **Den of Thieves** starring Gerard Butler, Pablo Schreiber, O'Shea Jackson Jr. and Curtis "50 Cent" Jackson; **Mary**, a supernatural thriller starring Academy Award winner Gary Oldman and Emily Mortimer; Hunter Killer, starring Gerard Butler and **6** Below, a modern prodigal son thriller based on the true story of a former Olympic hockey player who gets lost snowboarding in a storm.

In addition, Tooley produced the summer box-office hit **We're the Millers** which grossed \$270 million worldwide.

Prior to Tooley Entertainment, Tooley was President of Relativity, where he oversaw the company's day-to-day film and television operations. Under Tooley's leadership, Relativity Studios earned numerous Oscar® and Golden Globe® nominations, and three of its releases opened number one at the box office. In addition, he was instrumental in the launch of the company's television division which sold to private equity firms for \$125 million.

Tooley was an early advocate for and executive-produced David O. Russell's **The Fighter**, which earned seven Oscar nominations and won two. Also, he produced or executive-produced Neil Burger's **Limitless**, starring Bradley Cooper, and the action-thriller **Act of Valor**, both of which opened number one at the domestic box office. Other credits include **Dear John**, starring Channing Tatum; Nicholas Sparks' **Safe Haven**; and Steven Soderbergh's **Haywire**.

Tooley is a Member of the Producers Branch of the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences as well as the Producers Guild of America. He earned his B.A. at the University of California, Santa Barbara, and in 2009 was named "Executive of the Year" by the Ischia Global Film Festival.
